After lunch we headed back to the Harts'. There was a big traffic jam on Lost Dutchman Blvd and many found alternate routes back.



Hansen Family Legacy

This Model T was in the showroom of Hansen Ford in Idaho Falls. Farrel Hansen, Sr., was a businessman and farmer who made a significant impact on agriculture in Idaho. After Hansen's untimely death in 1949, his wife Lily assumed possession of the dealership. Though Ford Motor Company was progressive enough to allow women to work in their factories, they were not as forward-thinking with their dealerships

or salaried positions. Once they discovered Lily's ownership, they revoked her dealer license. Interestingly, Lily never learned to drive. This car was soon left to the elements on the family farm in Osgood. Many years later, it was fully restored by her son, former state senator John D. Hansen.
