## September Meeting

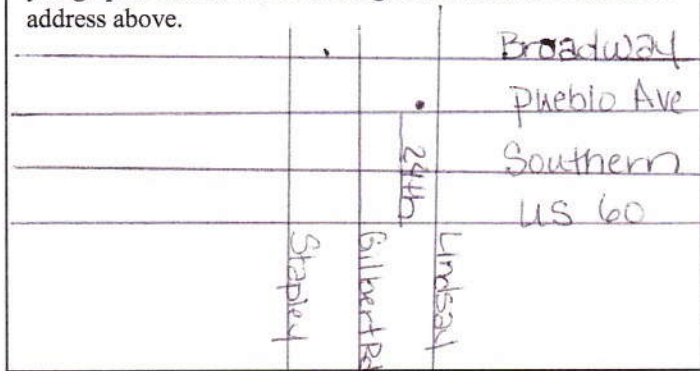
