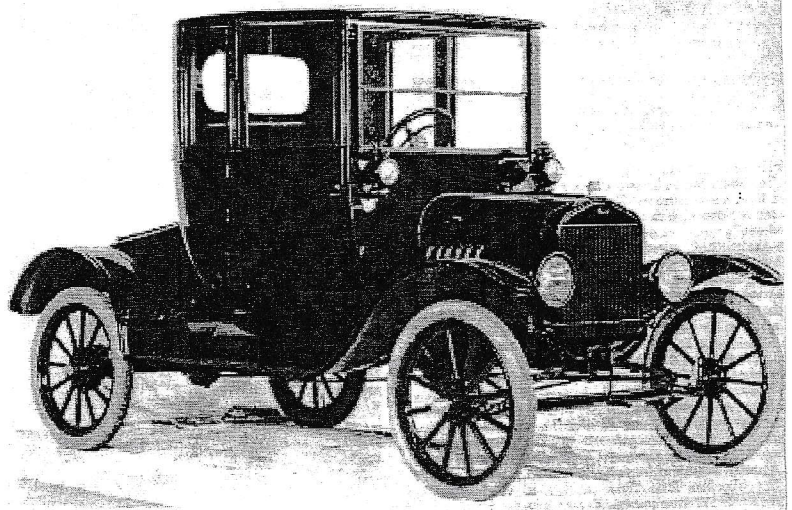

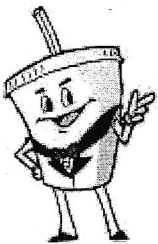
Breakfast Smoothie

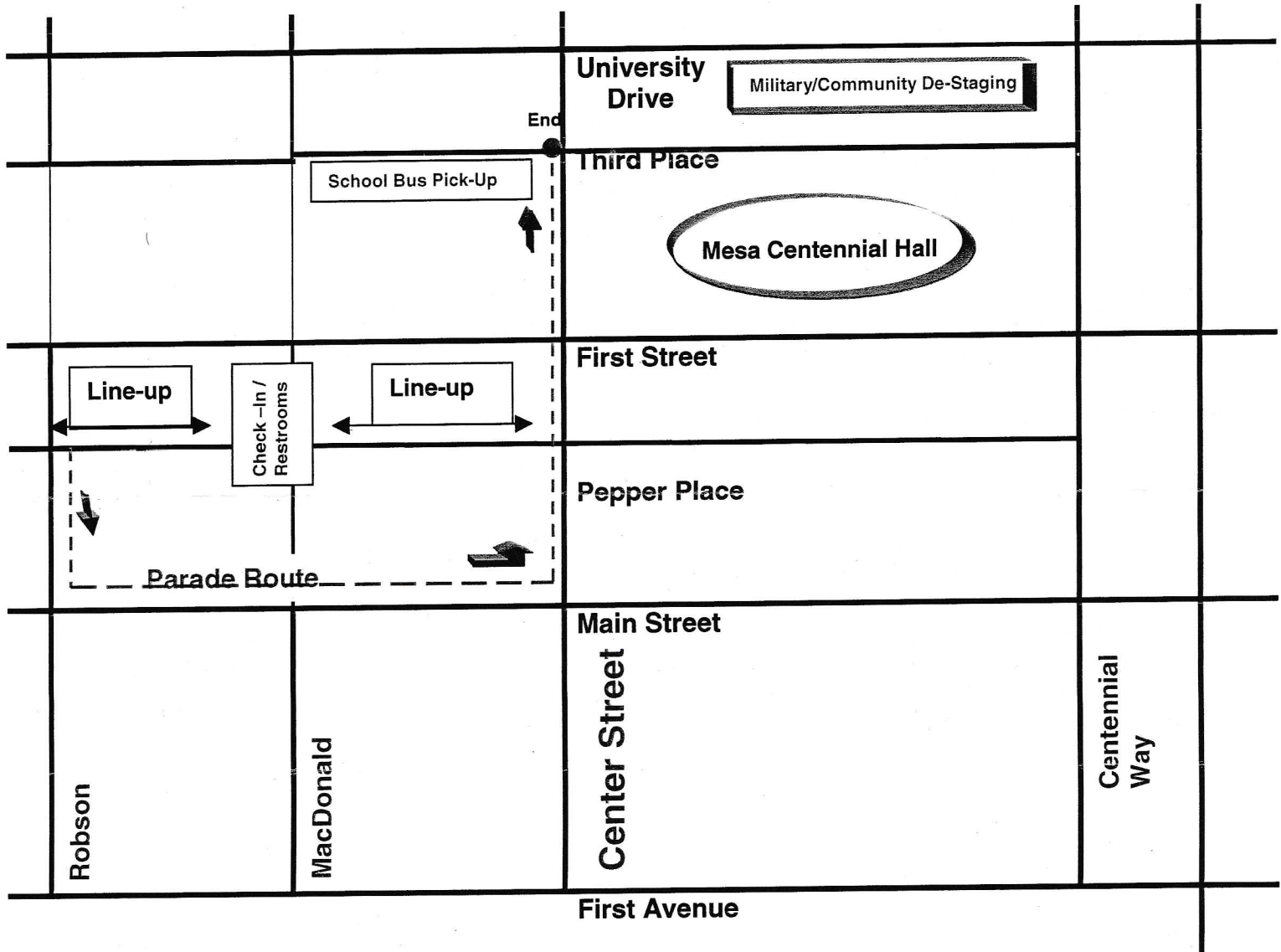

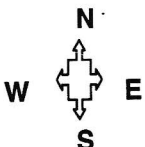

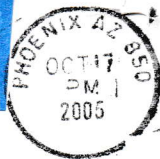
Map not to scale
