






What a great turnout. It was a little cool on the patio. Food was good as always!

#### **EVMTFC tours the USS Arizona Memorial Gardend at Salt River Field**

The USS Arizona Memorial Gardens at Salt River, spans the exact length and width of the USS arizona, with over 1,500 Commemorative Columns, outlining the exact premiter of the ship. Each column is representative of an individual aboard the USS arizona on December 7<sup>th</sup>, 1941. Each lit column represents an individual who pereshid during the attack and an individual who survived. As night falls, each column glows internaly with light, transforming the Gardens by momorializing each individual's internal light, one that will continue to glow and stand the test of time.







This memorial is located at 7455 North Pima Road.

The Penske Racing Museum is small but has a lot to see. It is located 7125 Chancey Ln. Phoenix AZ, and it is free!




## Following our tour of the Penske Racing Museum, we had lunch at the Blue Agavi Mexican Cantina. Yum brisket tacos!


