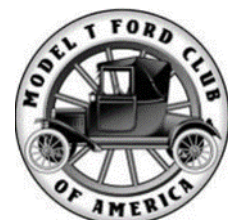
Membership Dues:



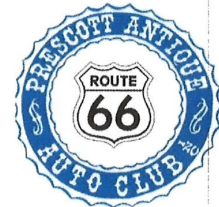

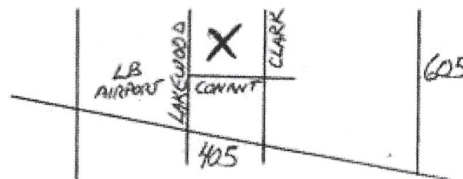
